Pupil Survey 2012/13 Summary



Recently our School Council have worked together to produce a questionnaire for other children in the school. Although the School Council does a brilliant job of informing staff of children's opinions, this is another great opportunity for children to anonymously share their views of their school.

Their views and opinions help prioritise areas of school development and child provision.

When asked whether they enjoy playtimes 97.8% of our children were satisfied, with an amazing 75% stating they were very happy. This was similarly reflected in other areas including:

- Whether they like their lessons
- Whether marking helps make their work better
- Whether they like their school dinner or packed lunch

Following the children's survey we will be reminding children of the importance of accessing support structures within the school, to increase even further their ability to resolve conflict.

We are very pleased with the children's responses and will continue to listen and act to ensure their needs are fully met.
