## 2014/15 Summary



This year our School Council worked together to produce a questionnaire for other children in the school. The School Council does a brilliant job of informing staff of children's opinions and this is another great opportunity for children to anonymously share their views of their school.

Their views and opinions help prioritise areas of school development and child provision.

When asked whether they enjoy playtimes 99.1% of our children were content, with an amazing 89% stating they were very happy. This was similarly reflected in other areas including whether they:

- Feel happy and safe at school
- Have good friends at school
- Believe their lessons are enjoyable

Following the children's survey we have made several changes to the assembly format to increase the children's enjoyment throughout the week.

We are very pleased with the children's responses and will continue to listen and act to ensure their needs are fully met.
