Mathematics

- Exploring numbers to 10 including:
 - representing numbers in different ways.
 - number formation
 - more than and less than a number
 - pairs
 - doubling
- Length and height
- Mass and capacity
- Time
- Exploring 3D shapes

Understanding the World-

- talk about similarities and differences with a focus on different African and Arctic animals
- find the Arctic, Antarctic and Africa on the map and find where they live on the map.
- find out about the different parts of their body and link to the five senses.
- learn about significant people in their own life and the achievements of Captain Robert Scott.

Literacy

- Book focuses: Lost and Found, Meerkat Mail and Handa's surprise.
- recognise and write their name
- listen to a range of fiction and non-fiction books
- daily phonics sessions- phase 3 and 4
- write familiar words in particular words with the sounds that they have learnt.
- write for a purpose
- re-tell stories that they have listened to.
- talk about characters in story books
- role play the stories I have heard through drama activities.
